

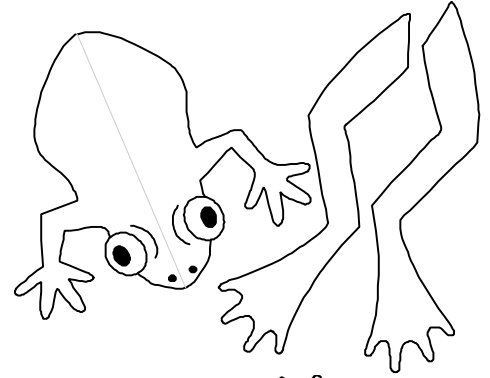
Frog

Materials

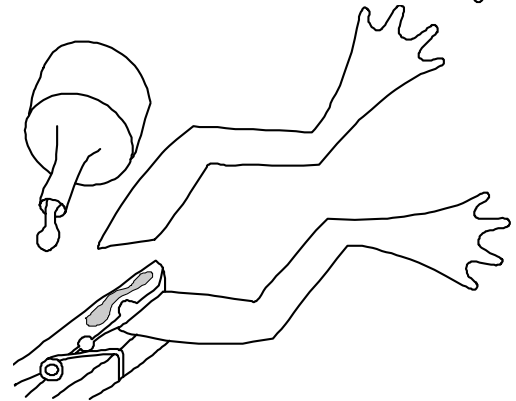
A4 card
Scissors
Clothes peg

Pencils
Sellotape
Pipe cleaner

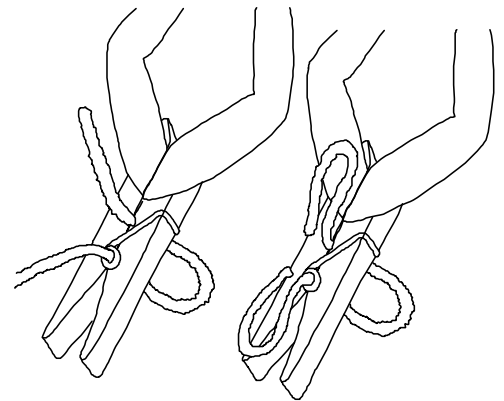
- 1 Trace round the templates for one frog's body and two legs.



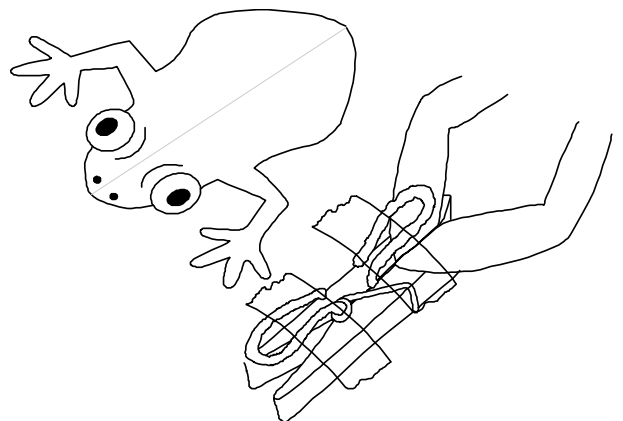
- 2 Glue one leg onto one side of the wooden peg.
Then carefully glue the other leg to the other side of the peg.
Leave to dry.



- 3 Bend the pipe cleaner in half.
Insert one end through the wire holding the peg together.
The other end of the pipe cleaner goes through the hole just before the legs.
Bend them round into loops.



- 4 Place some sticky tape underneath the two loops of the pipe cleaner.
Lace the body of the frog onto the tape with the head facing away from the legs.



- 5 When you squeeze the end of the peg together the legs will open, just like swimming.
