

Glass Etching

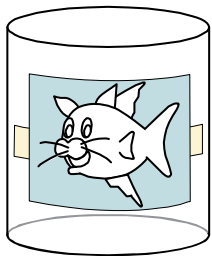
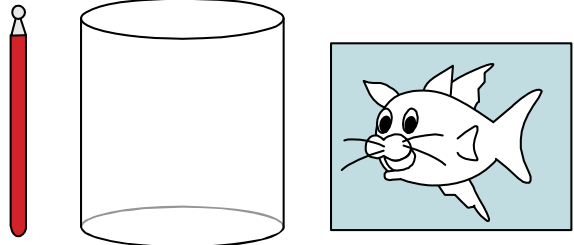
Glass
Design
Etcher

Scissors
Sellotape

You will need a clear smooth glass, thick enough so that it will not shatter in your hand when pressure is applied;

A design that will fit the size of the glass; and

An etching tool.

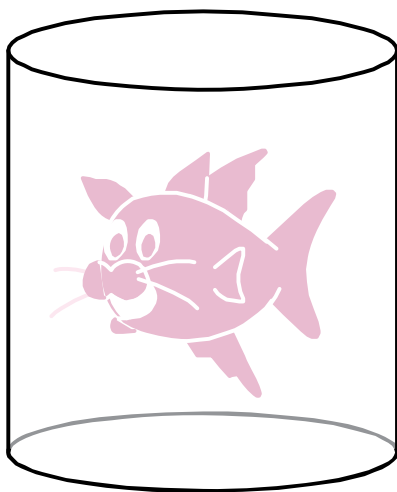
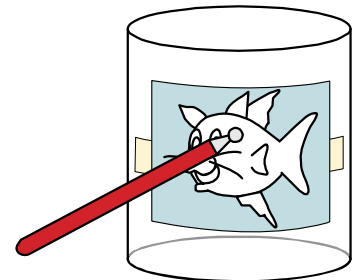


Take the design and secure it in place on the inside of the glass securely, using sellotape.

Begin by tracing around the outline of the design using the etching tool.

To fill in the design, use the etcher like a crayon and keep going over and over the design.

You can either leave the design in place or remove it to continue filling in.



If you have not already done so, remove the design from the completed glass.

REMEMBER

You have been removing minute particles of glass so your hands and the glass **MUST BE WASHED** as soon as possible.
