

Lolly Stick Notice Board

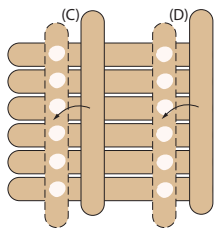
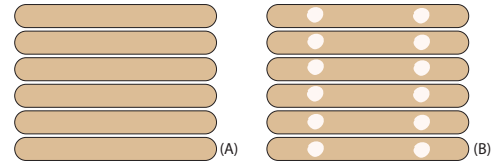
10 lolly sticks
PVA glue
Paintbrush

Hanging chord
Card

Colour pens
Newspaper (for protection when drying)

Using 6 lolly sticks, lay them on a flat surface equally spaced apart (A).

Put a drop of glue on each stick in two places, in straight lines (B).



Place a lolly stick, vertically onto the glue drops on the left hand side. Press down (C).

Now place another lolly stick, vertically onto the glue on the right hand side (D).

These should cover all the glue drops. Leave to dry.

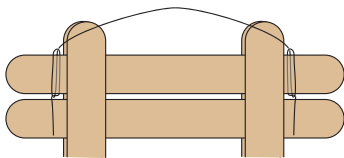
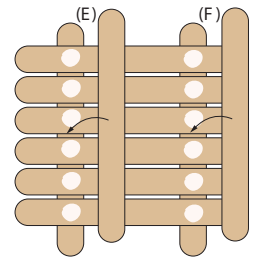
Turn the notice board over.

Put a drop of glue on each stick in straight making sure that they are in line with the vertical sticks at the back.

Place a lolly stick, vertically onto the glue drops on the left hand side. Make sure it is in the same position as the one on the reverse (E).

Now place another lolly stick, vertically onto the glue on the right hand side (F).

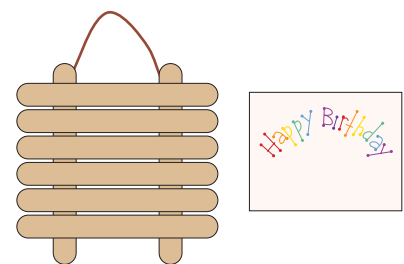
Leave to dry.



Take the hanging chord and wind it around each side of the top rung of the notice board and secure it tightly in place.

Take a piece of card the size you want that fits onto the notice board and write your message.

This can be fixed permanently with glue or use BlueTac for a non-permanent fixing.



When all the glue is dry you can varnish the notice board.

This can be done by mixing PVA glue with water, then applying it all over one side of the notice board and leave to dry.

Turn over and do the same to the other side, leave to dry.

The notice board is now ready to be hung up.
