

Magazine Beads

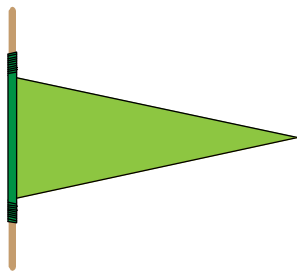
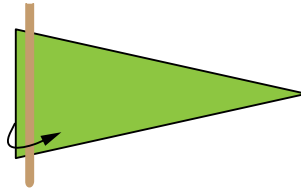
Thin dowel/kebab stick
Colourful magazines

Scissors
Glue

Pencil
Chord/Elastic

Cut out a cardboard triangle and use it as a template to cut triangles from colourful magazine pages.

Roll around a thin dowel or kebab stick.



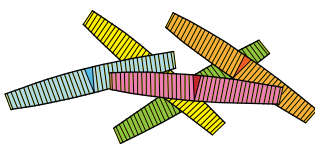
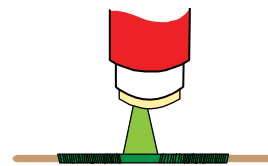
Starting at the wide end, roll the triangle tightly into a cylindrical bead shape.

Apply glue to the pointed end of the triangle.

Make sure the narrow end sticks firmly and the bead stays rolled up.

Apply another dot of glue if needed.

Slide the bead off the end of the dowel



Brush your beads with a solution of one part clear, white glue to two or three parts water.

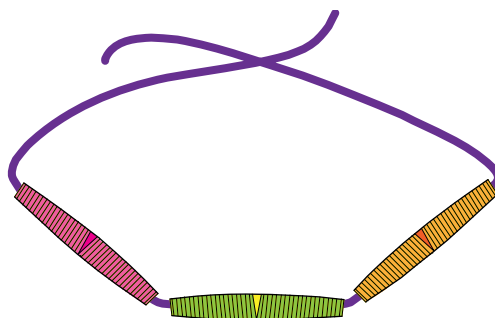
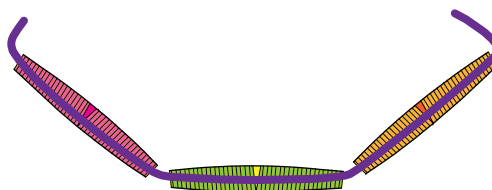
This is optional, but it will make the beads last longer and help to smooth out the surface.

Let them dry thoroughly, making sure they don't stick to anything while they dry.

Try hanging them on a string to dry

Make as many beads as you need.

String the beads together.
