

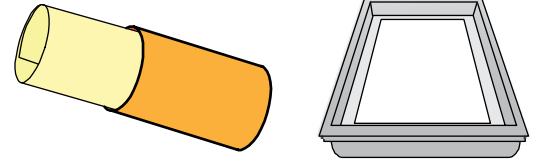
Marble Painting

Canister or tray
Paper

Marbles (or ping pong balls)
Paintbrush Poster paint

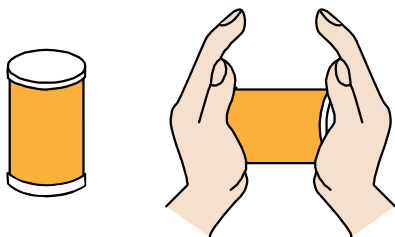
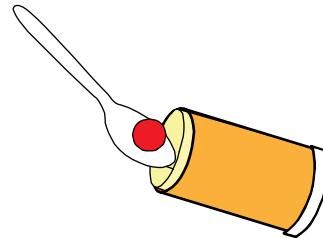
Plastic spoons
Paint containers

Cut paper to fit inside the bottom of the tray.
If you are using canisters, cut paper and roll it inside the canister.



Dip 2 to 3 marbles in one colour.
Use a spoon to move each marble around the paint.
The marble should be thoroughly coated with paint.

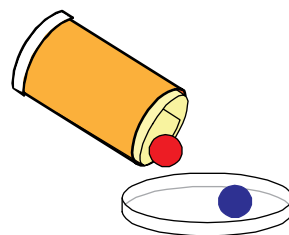
Scoop out the marbles and drop them into the canister or tray.



Cover the ends of the canister and start shaking, make sure that the ends will not come off.

If using a tray lift the tray and roll the marble around the paper.

Remove the ends and remove the marbles.
Repeat this process using one colour at a time.



When finished, check out the artwork.
The marbles make great abstract prints on the paper!

CAUTION

Marbles can be choking hazards.
Ping pong balls can be used as a safer alternative for children below the age of three.
