

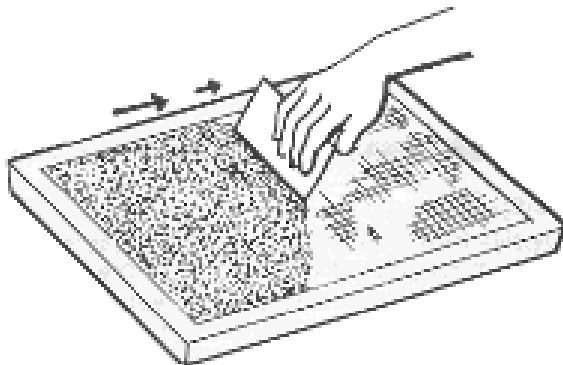
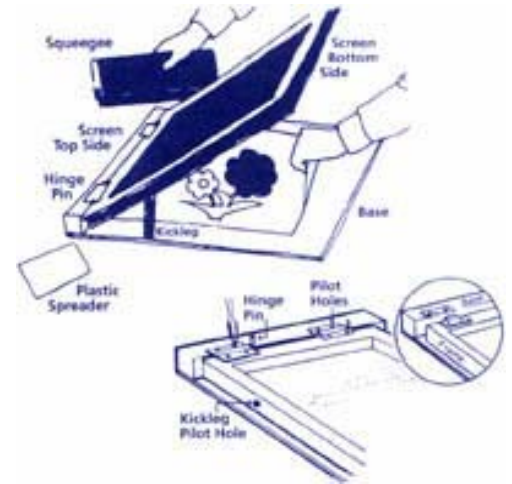
Screen Printing

Screen
Squeegee

Paper
Scissors

Stencil
Paint

Screen-printing is a printing process that uses a stencil. A stencil is placed on the screen, which acts as a mask. Then paint is applied by a squeegee, which forces the paint through the openings of the stencil thus printing an image on to a selected surface of your choice.



A design is cut out of paper.
The stencil is positioned under the screen frame.
A piece of paper is placed on the stencil.
Then paint is then squeegeed over the screen.

Carefully peel back the paper, leave somewhere flat to dry.

You can use the stencil about a dozen times. More if you are careful

Screen-printing can be done on many types of surfaces such as, fabrics, wood, metal, glass and papers
