

Wired Frog

2 pieces of wire

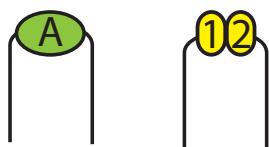
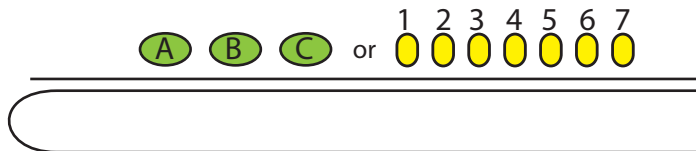
3 oval beads

or 7 crow beads

Cut two pieces of wire, one twice as long as the other.

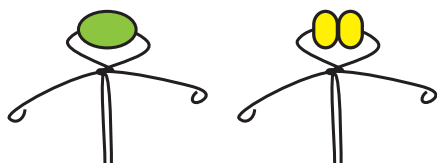
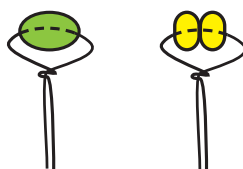
If you are using large oval beads then you will need 3 beads (A, B, C).

If you are using crow beads then 7 beads are needed (1 to 7).



Bend the longer piece of wire in half and add Bead A (Beads 1, 2).

Twist the wire twice under the beads.

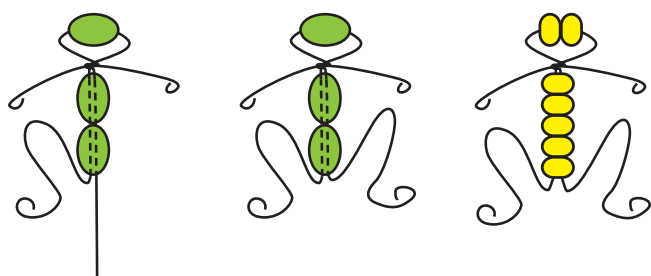
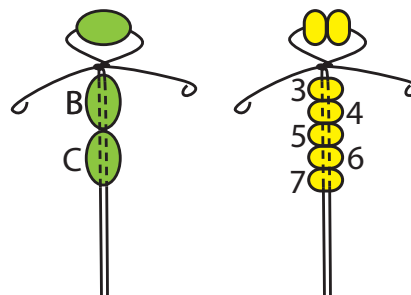


Add the shorter piece of wire for the arms under the twists.

Twist another two times to catch the arm wire in place.

Bend the wire at the two ends to form hands.

Add beads B and C (Beads 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7) to the two strands of wire.



To secure the body beads in place:

Take one end of wire and bend upwards, then continue bending into the leg shape require.

Bend the second end of wire in a mirror image.

The frog is now complete.
