

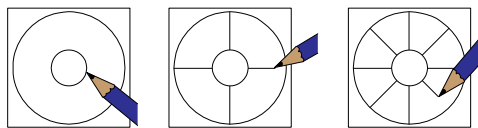
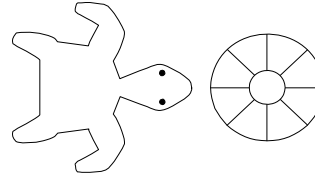
3-D Turtles

Card
Glue

Pencil
Scissors

Colour pens

Draw around the template for the turtle's body and cut out.
For the turtle's shell, draw a large circle on a piece of paper.
Draw a smaller circle in the middle.

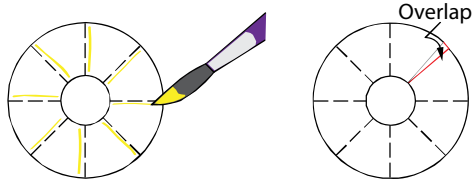
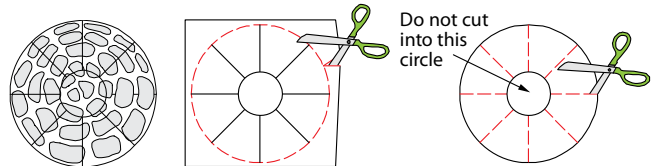


Draw a line going from the edge of the small circle to the edge of the big circle. Then, draw three more lines, spacing them evenly.

Draw lines in the spaces in between the lines. Space them out as even as you can.

There should be eight lines altogether.

Draw the turtle's shell onto the card and colour in.
Cut around the big circle.
Then cut along the straight lines, but don't cut around the small circle.

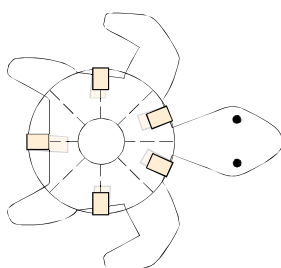
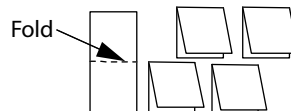


Brush a line of glue along one edge of each section.

To make the shell 3-D, slide the edge of one section over the glue on the one next to it.

Hold it until it sticks, then overlap all the other sections in the same way.

Cut 5 strips of card or paper fold each one in half.
Use these tabs to attach the shell to the body.

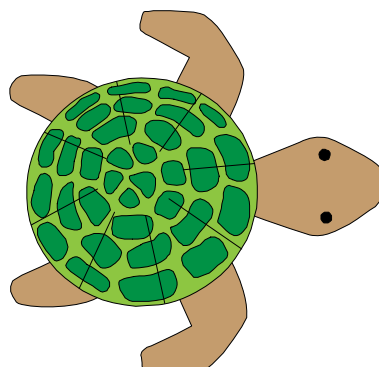


Glue the five tabs to the underneath of the shell in the positions shown.

Now turn the shell over, glue the other half the tabs take to the back of the body and glue in place.

Leave to dry.

Draw two black dots for eyes.
