

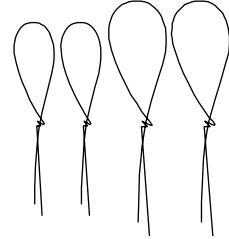
# Bead Dragonfly

Wire  
Fantasy Film

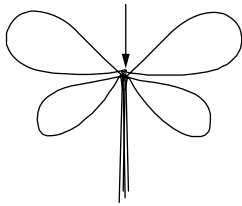
Beads

Using wire shape two large wings and two smaller wings.

These will be dipped into Fantasy Film so each shape will need to be sealed with a twist.



Twist together

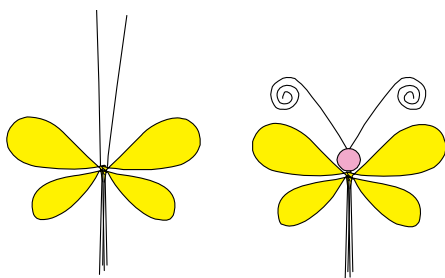
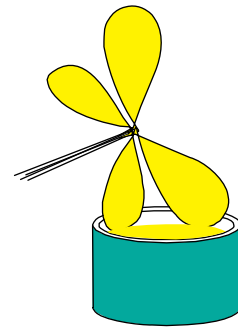


Take the four wings and twist all the parts together ready to be dipped.

Dip the wings into the Fantasy Film right up to the twists.

Remove slowly out of the film, let the drips stop then placed to one side to dry.

Drying time should be about 5 to 10 minutes.



Take another piece of wire and bend into a U shape.

Secure around the twist between the wings.

Take a bead and thread this onto the two wire strands and push down to the body.

This bead now becomes the head.

Bend the two strands of wire apart and twist each end into a twirl for the antennae.

Lastly place some beads over all the strands of wire from the wings to form the body.

Make this as long as you want for the dragonfly.

To secure all the beads at the end, take the wire and bend around the last bead, making sure that any ends are put back into the beads for safety.
