

Foam Caterpillar

Foam circles
2 foam large ovals
Beads

Wire
Permanent marker

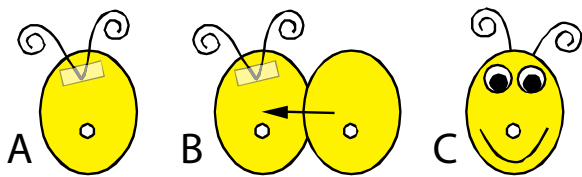
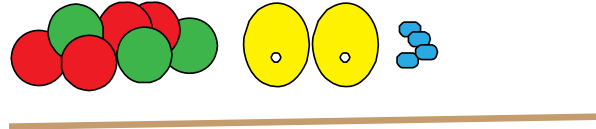
Cut as many circles of coloured foam as you need.

Punch a hole in each circle in the middle.

Also cut two large ovals for the head.

Punch a hole, two thirds down the oval.

Cut a length of wire long enough for your caterpillar.



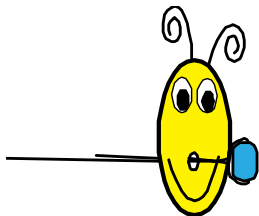
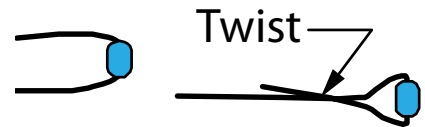
For the antennae, cut one piece of wire, fold in half and then curl each end.

Glue or tape the antennae in place on one of the larger ovals.

Take the remaining oval, glue all over one side then turn over and glue to the first oval.

Draw a face on this oval with a permanent marker, let the ink dry.

For the nose take a bead and place one end of the wire through and twist the two ends together tight to the bead.



Take the assembled nose and pass the wire through the hole in the double thickness head.

To assemble the caterpillar, alternate with a bead and a foam circle along the piece of wire as long as you require it to be.

At the tail end, pass the wire through the last bead and twist around it so that all the beads and foam discs do not fall off.

Tuck the end of the wire back through the foam discs.
