

Fork Flowers

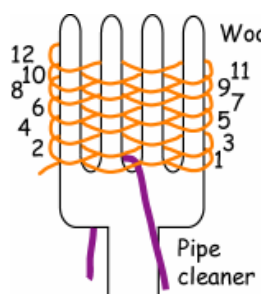
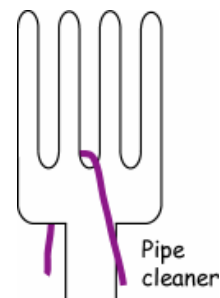
Equipment needed:

Metal fork
Wool

Plastic bag tie
Scissors

These flowers are easy to make and a great way to use up scraps of wool.

First place the pipe cleaner in the middle prong of the fork, bend the two ends down so that they are not in the way when winding the wool.



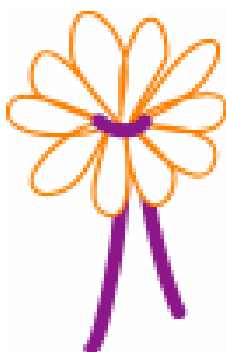
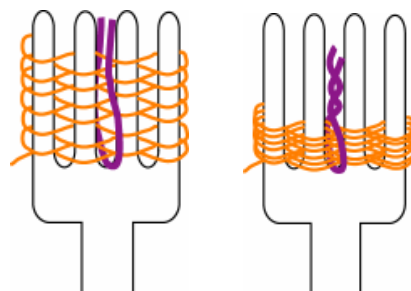
Wind the wool in and out of the prongs of the fork, going forwards and backwards.

The fewer times the wool is wound round the fewer the petals on the flower.

The more times the wool is wound round then there will be more petals.

When you have enough wool around the prongs then bend up the pipe cleaner and twist tightly.

(Make sure that the pipe cleaner is really tight before taking off the fork.)



Remove the flower from the fork and rearrange the petals to look like a flower.

If you require a stem then use a narrow straw and place the pipe cleaner ends in one end of the straw.

If you use a bendy straw the flower head can be used in an arrangement at an angle.
