

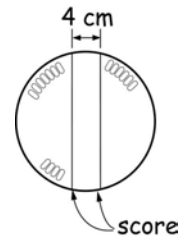
Rocking Yachts

Paper plate
Sharp knife
Scissors

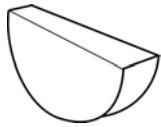
Scorer (optional)
Metal ruler (optional)

Glue
Tissue paper

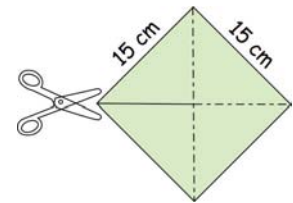
- 1 Place the plate laminate side up, find the centre of the plate and score two parallel lines 4 cm apart with a sharp knife against a metal ruler, scissors or scorer



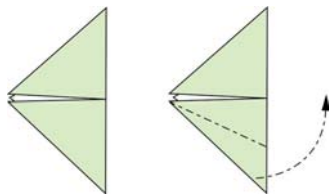
- 2 Then draw a sea scape on to the plate using strips of tissue paper and glue them to the plate and trim afterwards.



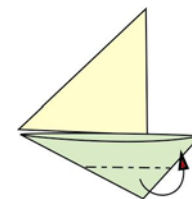
- 3 The yacht requires a 15 cm square of paper. Fold across both diagonals, and cut along one diagonal fold to the centre of the square.



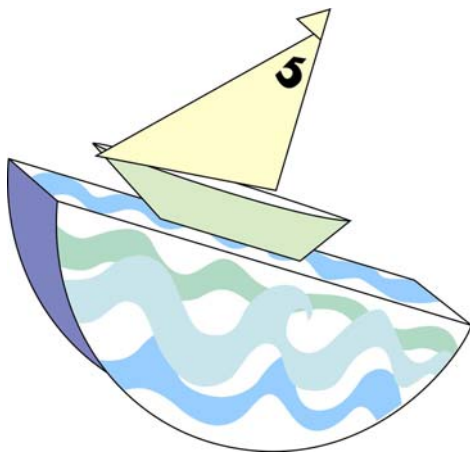
- 4 Fold in half along other diagonal
Fold bottom corner up.



- 5 Fold lower point of boat back and glue to the centre of the plate.
Decorate with a sail using another colour piece of paper.



- 6 The two sides of the plate are then held in place by a bridging piece of card, glued or taped in place.



Place some plasticine at one square edge which will aid the rocking motion.
