

Shaped Flowers

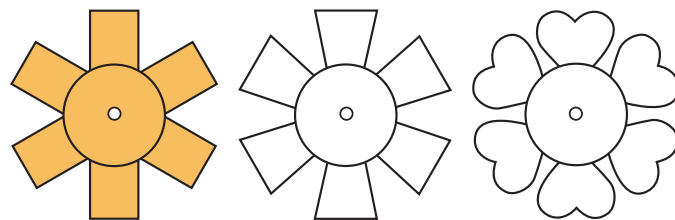
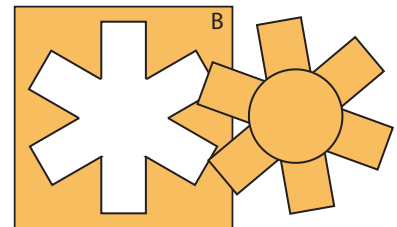
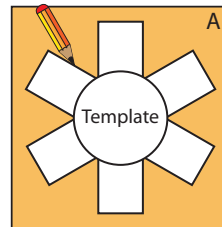
Colour card
Tissue paper
Cup-cake holder

Glue
Bendy drinking straw
2 pony beads

Pencil
Scissors

Draw around the template of the flower shape you require onto colour card (A).

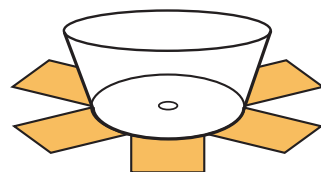
Cut it out (B).



Punch a hole in the centre of the circle of your flower, large enough for the straw to go through.

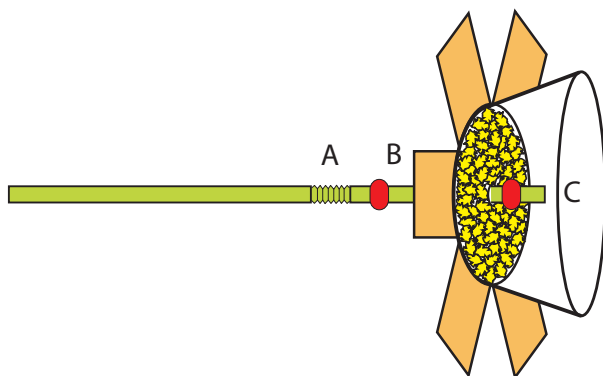
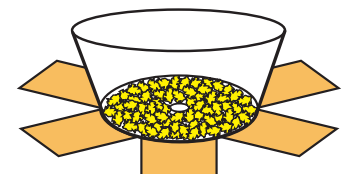
To make the leaves, draw and cut out two or three leaf shapes on green card.

Punch a hole at one end of the leaf large enough for the straw to go through.



Make a hole in the centre of the cup-cake holder and glue to the circle on the petal template matching up the holes.

Put some glue in the bottom of the cup-cake holder and screw up some small pieces of tissue paper and press into the glue to give the flower an inner.



To assemble the flowers, use the bendy end of the straw.

Put some glue onto one pony bead and place this onto the straw by the bends (A).

Next place the flower onto the straw up against the pony bead (B).

Lastly put some glue onto the second pony bead and put this onto the straw up against the flower (C).

To add the leaves.

Place the leaves along the long end of the straw and glue in place.
