

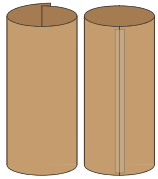
Windmill

A4 Card
Oddments of paper
Bead

Glue
Split pin
Sellotape

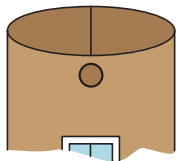
Scissors
Pencils
Single hole punch

Cut an A4 piece of card in half along the long side.
(Leaves 2 A5 sized pieces)



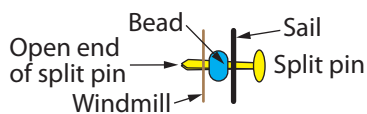
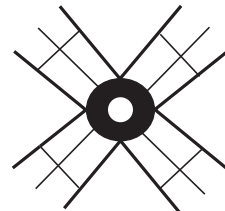
Roll the card into a circle and secure with sellotape.

Cut out the windows and a door from paper.
Glue into position on the windmill building on the opposite side to the join.



Using a single hole punch, make a hole near the top of the windmill building.
This is for the sail.

Using the single hole punch, make a hole through the middle of the sails.



To make up the windmill:
Take the split pin and insert through the hole on the sails.
Now insert through the bead (Hama beads are ideal)
Pass the split pin through the windmill building.
Lastly open the two ends of the split pin to secure in place.
